TO CLARIFY AND DEFINE THE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

A suitable tool to describe and concretize the objectives is to use the **infinitive form**, for instance:

- “The objective is **to** develop and implement a training programme that introduces artists to collaborative learning among vulnerable youngsters...”
- “The objective is **to** write a performance script in which young people will present their own life stories in an artistic setting...etc.

The **AIM** can be perceived as the overall **intention** in the short or long term
The **OBJECTIVES** represent the **actions** that can bring the intention to life.
